

- What is "Grand Prix Challenge"?

Muju Taekwondowon 2021 World Taekwondo Grand Prix Challenge is a G-1 level international Taekwondo competition, which is promoted by World Taekwondo and organized by Taekwondo Promotion Foundation (TPF).

- Who can participate in this competition?

The top 13 athletes of each Olympic weight category (based on WT Olympic ranking) that will be published for September 1, 2021, who were not in included in "Selected" athlete list in Sofia 2019 World Taekwondo GP can participate in this competition.

- When does the competition take place?

The competition takes place from November 4 to 6, 2021, for 3 days.

- When are arrival/departure date for overseas participants/officials? Everyone who does not live in Republic of Korea must arrive on October 27, 2021 and leave on November 7, 2021.
- How will the event venue operated due to current circumstance?

For a safe competition, all persons, including organizing staffs, event staffs, participants, officials and other competition relevant persons, will be staying at Taekwondowon. It means, accommodating, dining, training and all other activities will take place ONLY at Taekwondowon.
